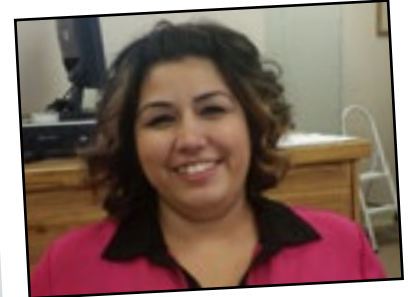

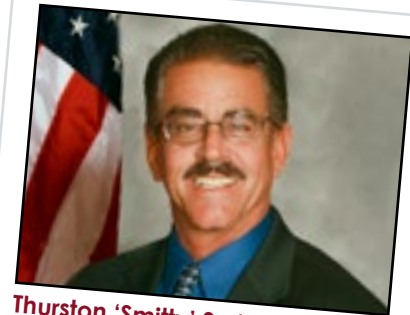

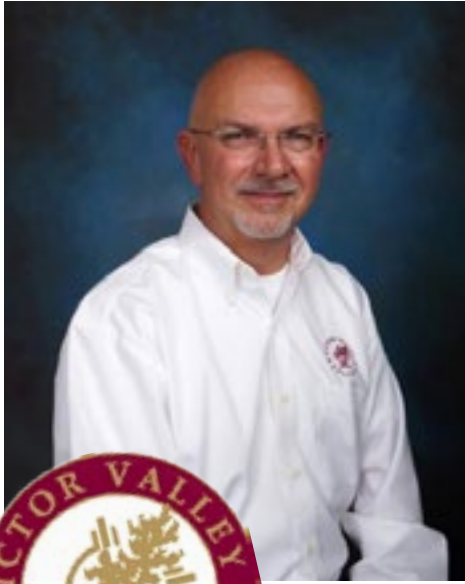

Great alumni hunt reconnected

More than 1,150 former Victor Valley College students were found through an innovative outreach effort that sought to reconnect alumni to their alma mater. The Great Alumni Hunt presented by Desert Valley Hospital and the Auto Park at Valley Center involved 13 teams locating and contacting college alumni in a competition to win scholarships for student interns.

The campaign began October 15 and concluded with a halftime announcement of Great Alumni Hunt winners at the November 15 regular season finale of the undefeated Rams Football team.

"Alumni are very important to Victor Valley College. They represent the results of our work to change lives for good," said Roger Wagner, Superintendent / President. "We hoped to reconnect with 500 in a way that made them part of something special, but more than twice as many were found."

Each outreach team in the hunt was led by a community volunteer, included a faculty or staff member from the College and was supported by a student intern. The winning team led by Mike Nutter of ISU / ARMAC Insurance, included Victor Valley College Webmaster Justin Gatewood, and was supported by VVC Intern I'tavia Peters who earned a \$2,500 scholarship for her team's performance.

"I thank the Lord for bringing strength to my team especially to my team captain, Mike Nutter. The alumni were amazing for helping too. I had so much fun and learned a lot," said Peters.

Team "Tay", as they were known, were responsible for connecting with 454 alumni and earned more than 2,750 points to take first place. Points were awarded based on the number of alumni they found, meeting challenges that included finding specific categories of alumni, and for bringing alumni to the football game.

"This was a blast," said Nutter. "We found some amazing people among VVC Alumni and they love their alma mater. Our team even found the Valedictorian of VVC's first graduating class, Ms. Norma Stafford."

CAREER DESCRIPTION:

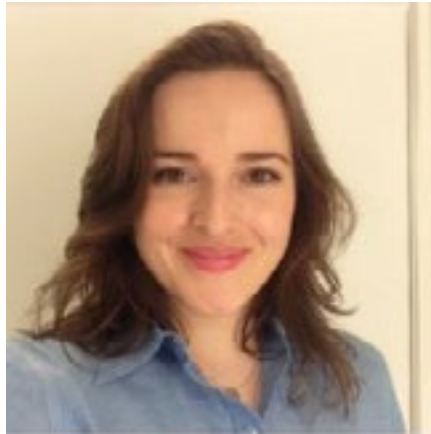

Through research, interviews and surveillance, fraud investigators make sure that claims for reimbursement are not false. Fraudulent cases may involve worker's compensation, staged accidents, welfare, taxes, social benefits and property damage. These investigators often work with claims examiners to put an end to fraudulent claims at the start of the process.

CAREER DESCRIPTION:

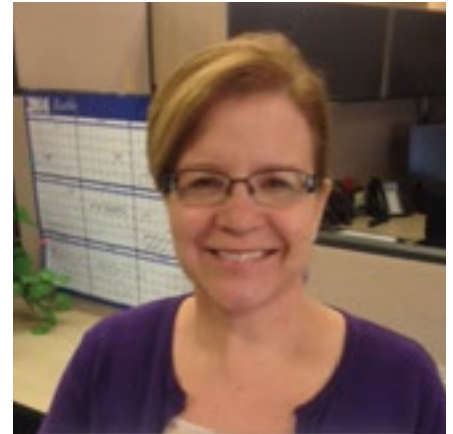

Teachers act as facilitators or coaches, using interactive discussions and "hands-on" approaches to help students learn.

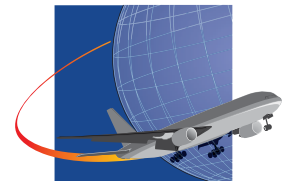
